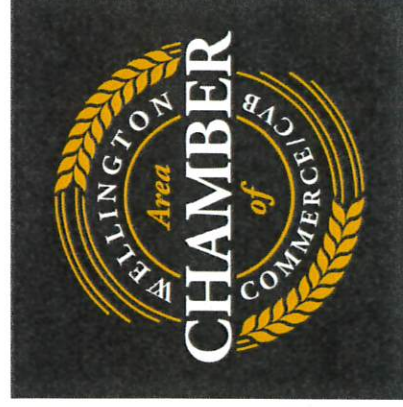

PARADE ELIGIBILITY

PARADE FLOATS

- Entrants must sign the entry form to reflect that they have received and agreed to the rules. Anyone not complying will be asked to leave the parade and will not receive a spot in the line up.
- **NO LATE ENTRIES** after Friday, July 5th, 2019 at 5 p.m. will be considered, **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**

HORSE/ANIMAL POLICY

- There be an identified Wheat Parade Horse Specialist who will line up horses.
- Horses are not allowed to line-up prior to 7:30 p.m.
- **ALL HORSES** will be at the end of the parade, no horses will be allowed to be in the Line Up before any vehicles or floats with sounds.
- **ALL HORSES**, with exception of horses pulling wagons, carts, or trailers **MUST HAVE A RIDER** on them at all times, **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**

NOTE: The Parade Line Up is near the railroad/train tracks, and the parade has entries, which include canons, loud vehicles, and other loud and frequent noises. We ask that if your horse is not use to loud sounds that it not be entered into the parade.

119th Kansas Wheat Festival Officials reserves the right to request an entry to leave the parade in the case that the rules, regulations, and guidelines are not being followed, and if it appears that it could be a dangerous situation.

PARADE RULES

- The Parade is open to individuals, businesses & groups.
- Parade Line Up will be emailed by 5 p.m. on Thursday, July 11, 2019.
- Line-up begins at 6:45 p.m. outside of City Hall: 317 S. Washington, Wellington, KS 67152
- Judging begins at 7:00 p.m., must be lined up by 6:45 p.m.
- Throwing candy or anything from a float/vehicle into the crowd is **NOT ALLOWED!!!**
- Walkers may distribute candy, marketing materials to parade attendees.

PARADE ENTRY CATEGORIES

- **COMMERCIAL ENTRY:** Pick-up, mini van, SUV, large trucks, trailer with flatbed, antique tractor, passenger cars, classic car, any motorized vehicle, bicycles, etc.
- **NON-PROFIT ENTRY:** Schools, church, faith group, fair, festival, 4-H, FFA, social services, clubs, organizations, associations, etc.
- **POLITICAL:** Political, Elected Officials
- **INDIVIDUAL:** Families, individuals, etc.
- **ANIMAL:** Horse(s), horse riders, horse drawn units, dog, any animal, etc.
- **OTHER:** Anything not included in categories above.
