

City Sales Tax – Ordinances Implementing

1978 – Ordinance No. 3216	½ % (no expiration) (there is hereby levied a city retailers’ sales tax in the amount of one-half of one percent (0.005) to take effect on the first day of February, 1979)
1983 – Ordinance No. 3358	½ % (no expiration) (levying of an additional retailers’ sales tax in the amount of one-half of one percent (.005) making a total of one percent (.01) in the City of Wellington. Taking effect on the 1 st day of July, 1983)
2003 – Ordinance No. 3883	¼ % (10 yr period, expires 12/31/2013) (there is hereby levied a retailers’ sales tax in the amount of one-fourth of one percent (0.0025) for the period of ten (10) years only for the purpose of financing the provision of health care at St. Luke’s Hospital d/b/a/ SRMC. Taking effect on the first day of January 2004)
2012 – Ordinance No. 4111	½% (3 yr period, expires 7/1/2015) (there is hereby levied a retailers’ sales tax in the amount of one-half of one percent (.005) for the period of three (3) years only for the purpose of financing the provision of health care at St. Luke’s Hospital, d/b/a/ SRMC. Taking effect on the 1 st day of July 2012)
2014 – Ordinance No. 4170	1% (Effective 4/1/2015, 10 yr period expiring 4/1/2025, it also repealed existing ½% effective 4/1/2015) (Ordinance levying a retailers sales tax at the rate of one percent (1%) for the purpose of financing the provision of health care services at St. Luke’s Hospital d/b/a/ SRMC for a period of 10 years commencing on April 1, 2015 and ending April 1, 2025 as well as repealing, effective April 1, 2015, the existing .5% retailers’ sales tax in place for the same purpose.)

Other Sales Tax info

Nov 2010 election – Sumner County approved a ½% (.005) sales tax. It will expire in April 2014.

Apr 2013 election – Sumner County placed question on ballot extending the ½% (.005) for four more years.
