

2019 OFFICIAL RULES

KANSAS WHEAT FESTIVAL MEDALLION HUNT

Sponsored by Sumnernewscow.com and Bank of Commerce.

Publication of the clues begin July 1, 2019

- 1 Anyone is eligible to join the hunt for the Kansas Wheat Festival Medallion **except 2018 winners**, those persons directly involved in the planning and implementation of the Kansas Wheat Festival Medallion Hunt and members of their immediate families or households. The participant claiming the medallion prize must be **18 years old or older**.
- 2 The first clue will be issued July 1, 2019, through Sumnernewscow.com, the Chamber of Commerce office, Wellington Daily News website and The Wave radio stations. A new clue will be released each weekday by 10:00 am through Friday, July 12, 2019, unless the medallion is found earlier. Early birds may obtain the day's clue on Sumnernewscow.com between 6:30 and 7:00 am each weekday. The finder of the medallion must have registered their button to claim the \$1,000 prize. The purchase of a Kansas Wheat Festival button is not required to receive the \$100 prize. Buttons **must** be registered by June 28, 2019 and may be registered at Panhandle Federal Credit Union during business hours either in person or by phone.
- 3 The finder of the Kansas Wheat Festival Medallion **must** present it to Tracy McCue at Sumner NewsCow. Upon finding the Medallion, please call Tracy at 620-326-0717; he will arrange a meeting to accept the Medallion and interview the finder. The winner will be announced publicly on the Sumner Newscow website. **Any deception on any social media site will not be tolerated.** If the Kansas Wheat Festival Medallion is not found by 3:00 pm Friday, July 12, a last clue will be issued at that time through Sumnernewscow.com, the Chamber of Commerce office, Wellington Daily News website and The Wave radio stations. Arrangements will be made with the winner for presentation of the cash prize at a Wheat Festival event.
- 4 Sponsors of the hunt reserve the right to disqualify any participant for the following: **unsportsmanlike, abusive, deceptive, obscene, offensive, unsafe and/or harassing behavior; any participant who violates/enters private property, vandalism, and/or defacing private or public property (i.e. digging, sawing, damaging in any manner).** Sponsors reserve the right to terminate the medallion hunt at any time due to the above instances.
- 5 The medallion cannot be transferred, duplicated, auctioned or sold. Sponsors shall not be liable for injuries, losses or damages of any kind from participation in the Medallion Hunt.

The Medallion is located on public grounds (defined as Federal, State, County [within three miles surrounding the city limits] and/or City owned property). Again, everyone is reminded that digging, sawing and/or defacing public or private property will not be tolerated.

NOTE: The Medallion will NEVER be hidden in a cemetery, the Wellington Public Golf Course or in Stewart Dog Park.
