2. Accepted entries must meet all conditions outlined in the prospectus. The artist must meet all conditions outlined in the prospectus.

3. Artists assume responsibility for properly packing artwork to guard against damage during delivery.

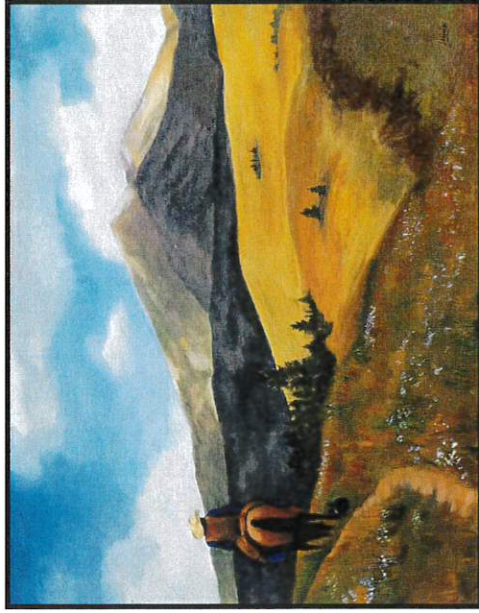
4. The Downtown Art Exhibit and the Wellington Area Chamber of Commerce will not be liable for artwork submitted to the exhibition. The artist bears all responsibility for any insurance coverage related to the exhibition and/or transportation of their artwork.

5. Unclaimed artwork: if artwork is not picked up at the times outlined in the prospectus or other arrangements have not been made for pick up prior to August 31st, the Downtown Art Exhibit and/or the Wellington Area Chamber of Commerce will dispose of the artwork in any way it sees fit without liability or further notice to the artist or lender.

6. Accepted entries, after being submitted, may not be removed before the close of the exhibition. No substitutions will be allowed.

7. Anyone inquiring about possible purchase of artwork will be directed to the artist. The Downtown Art Exhibit and/or the Wellington Area Chamber of Commerce will not be responsible for handling the purchase or delivery of artwork.

Eligibility

The exhibit is open to all artists living in Kansas. Each entry must be an original, wholly designed and executed by the artist. The size shall not exceed 60 inches in any direction.

Media Limitations

Acceptable artwork will consist of: paintings using oil, acrylic, watercolor or other similar media, graphite pencil, charcoal, colored pencil and pen and ink, sculpture and assemblage pieces, mixed media, computer generated original work and photography.

Mating and Framing

All two-dimensional pieces must be matted and framed and ready to be hung (wire or saw-tooth hanger). W/CAN has the right to reject any piece not ready to be hung. Gallery wrap canvases do not require matting or framing.

Artwork Accepted/Rejected

The Downtown Art Exhibit and the Wellington Area Chamber of Commerce/CVB have the right to reject any piece deemed inappropriate for the exhibit.

Professional vs. Amateur

An artist is deemed a professional if he/she creates artwork for purposes of financial gain. Artist who create artwork for personal pleasure and with no intent to sell are deemed amateur.
